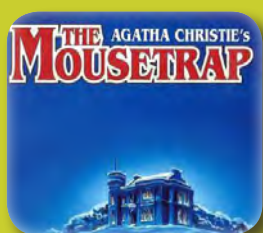
**MOON OVER BUFFALO (play)**
